

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLECTING REFERENDUM PETITION SIGNATURES

### Circulator Must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen and aged 18 years or older. (May reside anywhere, including out of state and does not have to be a registered voter.)
- **PERSONALLY WITNESS EACH PETITIONER SIGNING.**
- You may sign your own petition if you are a **REGISTERED VOTER in the jurisdiction.**
- Ensure each petitioner has printed his/her name and added their street address (No P.O. Boxes) **Note:** Circulator may write in ***just*** the name and address of petitioner.
- ***Carefully*** fill out the top section of the petition.
- **CIRCLE**  **THE CORRECT DESIGNATION for the municipality VILLAGE OR CITY** (see the excel spreadsheet or google search your municipality to see if it is a village or city.)
- Be sure to **FILL IN** the name of City or Village.
- ***Carefully*** fill in the bottom section of the petition, with your current correct address, circle  Village or City, and fill in the name of municipality.
- **DO NOT SIGN** affidavit **UNTIL** in front of a Notary Public and have it notarized **and** stamped.
- **Note: a Notary Public cannot sign as a petitioner on the same petition they are notarizing.**
- If petitioner makes a mistake, just cross out, signer initials mistake and then write/sign on the next line. **DO NOT USE WHITE-OUT.**
- If you copy and share petitions with friends, please be sure to give them copies of both pages of instructions.

### Petition Signer Must:

- Be a **REGISTERED VOTER.**
- Circulator: Please ask if signer is a registered voter and if they have signed the petition elsewhere—only one signature is allowed.
- Please have the signer print their name and address including the **name of City or Village, no ditto marks.** Township designation is unnecessary, since municipalities may straddle more than one township.
- Be sure that the signer's address is within DuPage County.
- Each voter/petitioner may sign their own petition—spouses cannot sign for each other.
- **ALL VOTER INFORMATION MUST BE THE SAME AS ON THEIR CURRENT REGISTRATION AT THE DUPAGE COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION OFFICE.**
- Encourage people to verify if they are currently registered with DuPage County Election Commission and re-register if necessary.

- The petition sheet must be reproduced on 8 1/2" x 11" white paper. **Partially filled sheets can be sent in.**
- No staples or any extra MARKS are allowed on petition outside the lines. **Please verify that each sheet is notarized before sending them in or we will not be able to use them.**
- **Please leave Office Use spaces open.**
- **DO NOT NUMBER THE SHEETS.**

Our petitions will be scrutinized more than others, so please do your best to follow the instructions carefully.
